

  - Lacking strategic direction












- Citizen Science

- Coincidence Mapping















#### **Questionnaire Results**

- 16 organisations
- 89% already collaborate
- $\bullet$  83% use data collected by other organisations
- 73% think that extra data would be useful
- 78% of surveys are part of a wider monitoring scheme
